Practical information

Who can participate in the training course?

- the training course is designed for youth workers and NGO leaders from Germany, Poland, Latvia, Ukraine, Belarus and Armenia
- a person speaking English (communicative)
- a person with recommendation letter from NGO, university, local authorities or civil society institutions from the home town or place of living

Dates:

Participants have to arrive to Münster by **21:00 on Tuesday, March 31**. Return tickets should be purchased for Wednesday, April 8. Participants can depart after breakfast.

Travel arrangements:

Participants are responsible for securing their own tickets. Original tickets and copy of the return tickets have to be presented during the registration. Participants are encouraged to look for moderate travel expenses.

Organizer of the training course will reimburse 70% of the travel costs.

Venue:

The training course will take place in Münster, at the Bennohaus Centre, Bennostrasse 5, 48-155 Münster, Germany (Nordrhein – Westphalia).

The training will be conducted by the qualified media specialists from Citizens' Center Bennohaus in Münster using developed and approved modules. Theoretical presentations will be intertwined with interactive group work, workshops and hands on experience in creating media products. Bennohaus being the comprehensive media center will offer professional and comfortable environment for trainings of the international group.

Accommodation&meals:

Participants will be accommodated in comfortable student hostels in Münster. Daily meals will be provided.

What to take?

Participants are encouraged to bring promotional materials from their organizations, information and materials of country presentations, especially video materials.

You can become youth web TV reporter:

The training seminar is organized by European association – European Youth4Media Network e.V. This organization is strongly working on developing European web TV (www.owtv.de, www.ngotv.eu). We are looking for interested civil society institutions, who are willing to cooperate with us and join our network.

Building up a network of youth web TV reporters will allow initiating and maintaining the cross-border web TV programs like «**Youth in Action TV**» - the initiative promoting opportunities that the Youth in Action Program offers to young people in Europe.
